



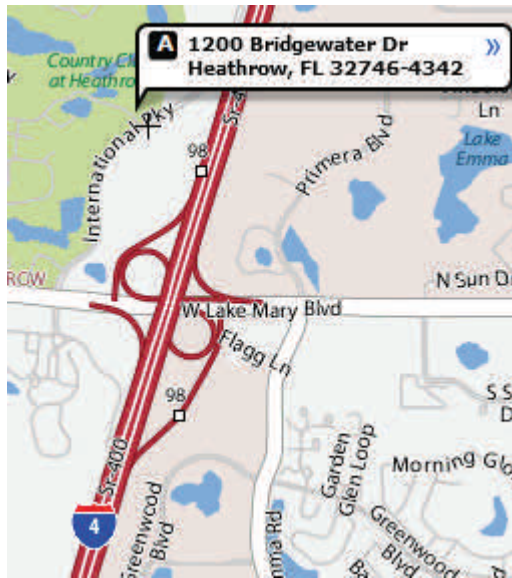

UCF Medical School Tour

Tuesday, Sept 27



Inside the Arts will start our season of autumn activities with an in-depth tour of the UCF College of Medicine at 6850 Lake Nona Blvd. in Orlando on Tuesday, September 27, 2011. Members and guests are welcome to attend. Deadline to sign up is Tuesday, September 20, 2011. Please assemble in the Atrium of the Medical Education Building (the half-circle-shaped building with the clock tower) at 9:45 a.m. after entering through the front center doors. The tour will depart promptly at 10 a.m.

Join us for an insider's look at how the UCF College of Medicine is transforming the education of physicians. Depending on availability, tour highlights will include the college's auditorium, medical library, anatomy lab and clinical skills facilities. In addition, we will discuss what it means to be a medical student today, explore plans for the development of the Medical City at Lake Nona, and examine the College of Medicine's impact on medical education across the country.

Parking: Free nearby parking in Lot P3 (not labeled) is available for all tour participants. However a parking pass is needed. This pass can be e-mailed to you in advance or distributed at the September luncheon. If you don't have e-mail, we will have extra passes available in the atrium which you can place in your car prior to the start of the tour.

Directions: From Oviedo/Winter Springs: Take 417 South to Exit 19-Lake Nona Blvd. Turn left onto Lake Nona Blvd. Ronnie will e-mail a map with driving/parking directions to all participants. Please allow adequate driving time to reach the area and volunteer to carpool with others who need rides. (The new medical school facilities may not be shown on some GPS units.) From the Winter Springs 417 Greenway entrance (Exit 44), the driving time is approximately 35-40 minutes.

Lunch: Order from the menu at The Cafe following the tour at noon. If you need to skip lunch or want to dine elsewhere, it's no problem. Just try to let Ronnie know by the RSVP date if possible. If you'd like to see a sample Cafe menu, please e-mail Ronnie at ronnie@telzer.com The Cafe serves a variety of items including burgers, pizza, grilled chicken, and daily soup and sandwich specials. The Cafe accepts cash, credit and debit cards.

Accessibility: This is a walking-intensive two-hour tour. Since you must stay with the group at all times, please consider bringing your own cane, walker or wheelchair (and a friend to push the wheelchair if necessary). Elevators are available throughout the tour so you won't have to climb stairs.

Cost: There is no charge for this tour. Cash, credit and debit cards are accepted at The Cafe. However, we need an accurate advance head count in case the size of our group requires a second tour guide and to make sure that The Cafe is ready to serve our group.
