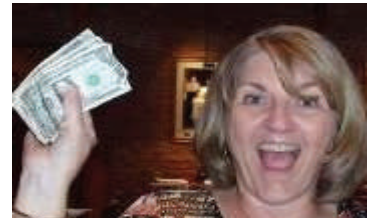
Just a reminder - Please do not arrive at the restaurants before 11:30 am. They are not set up for us yet and it makes for much confusion. Many thanks!!
